Active Ingredient

The active ingredient in EContra is a hormone called levonorgestrel, which has been used in birth control for many years.

Stops Pregnancy Before it Happens

EContra is not an abortion pill. EContra works by stopping or delaying the release of an egg from the ovary.

Time Sensitive

EContra needs to be taken within 72 hours of unprotected sex.

No Prescription or ID Required

EContra is delivered fast, discreetly, and without a prescription or ID.

EContra FAQs

- ➔ **What are the side effects of EContra?**

Taking EContra can cause some side effects that are usually mild. These may include changes in your period, stomach pain, nausea, vomiting, tiredness, headaches, dizziness, and breast tenderness.
- ➔ **Is EContra an abortion pill?**

No. It is a backup method of birth control used to prevent pregnancy by stopping or delaying an egg from being released at all. Without an egg, there's no chance of getting pregnant in the first place.
- ➔ **Does EContra protect against sexually transmitted diseases?**

No, EContra does not protect against HIV/AIDS or other sexually transmitted infections.
- ➔ **What makes EContra different from regular birth control?**

Regular birth control works *before* unprotected sex, EContra works *after*. EC is not meant for daily use. It's a backup when you need one.
